ATCC highly recommends that appropriate personal protective equipment is always

For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Growth Conditions

Medium:

ATCC Medium 2091: Sulfobacillus disulfidooxidans medium

Temperature: 35°C
Atmosphere: Aerobic
Incubation: With shaking

Handling Procedures

- 1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
- 2. Using a single tube of #2091 broth (5 to 6 ml), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 ml with a Pasteur or 1.0 ml pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.
- 3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.

- 4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate additional broth tubes, and a plate of a non-selective medium.
- 5. Incubate all tubes at 35°C with shaking for 48 to 72 hours. Incubate plate at 35°C.

Notes

This organism does not grow on agar therefore no growth should be detected on the non-selective plate. Cells are Gram positive rods that occur singly and in pairs. As the culture ages the cells may appear pleomorphic.
