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ATCC highly recommends that appropriate personal protective equipment is always used when handling vials. For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

Handling Procedures

- 1. Just prior to inoculation, place the frozen vial at room temperature to thaw.
- 2. Transfer the entire contents of the vial to a tube of #1545 broth (5 to 6 mL).
- 3. Use several drops of the cell suspension to inoculate a #1545 agar slant and/or plate. Additional #1545 broth tubes may be inoculated by transferring 0.5 mL



BAA-547 the primary tube to each addition broth tube.

4. Incubate the tubes and plate at 37°C for 3-5 days.

Notes

This organism is methylotrophic but will grow on non-selective media such as nutrient or tryptic soy. No growth occurs on TSA with Sheep Blood. This culture grows poorly in broth culture - it grows in clumps that have a slight pink pigmentation.
